Dressage Trail Horse I

Lendon's Youth Dressage Festival

Objective: To demonstrate obedience, handiness and response to rider's aids. The horse must softly accept the bit and may show more "roundness" in the parts of the test separate from the obstacles.

Conditions: Posting is optional. Transitions into and out of the halt may be done through the walk. Test may be called. To be shown in the small (20 x 40-meter) arena. Average time: 3:30 (schedule 5:30). Maximum possible points: 140 (2 bonus points if rider completes #8 while still holding the ball. 1 bonus point if judge actually catches the ball in #9.)

	Test	Points	Remarks
1. A X	Enter working trot Halt, salute. Proceed working trot. (Ground poles placed at L/I)		
2. C	Track right. Negotiate shallow serpentine of 5 cones inside track on long side.		
3. A	Working walk. Turn right on quarterline and negotiate U-shaped rails. Track right.		
4. V	Halt. Pick up object on top of stack of hay bales. Walk to near E and deposit object on top of second stack of bales.		
5. E C A	Working trot Track right Track left		
6. A	After turning, working walk. Negotiate 5-cone serpentine on long side.		
7. R	Pick up ball from top of stack of hay bales. Working trot, one-handed.		
8. C	20-meter circle, one-handed.		
9. C	At the end of the circle, toss ball to (<i>not at</i>) the judge. If you're no longer holding the ball, then just wave to the judge.		
10. E	10-meter half circle to X. Halt between X and ground rail. Salute.
